## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS - 'Young researcher' Prize**

## August 2024

Each year, the Fondation des Treilles awards a "Young Researcher" prize to French or foreign researchers at the end of their thesis carrying out their research in France. This prize is open to all disciplines. It is worth 6,000 euros. The prize is awarded by the Scientific committee of the Fondation des Treilles. It is awarded at a ceremony at which the laureate commits to attend.

- Candidates must be under 35 years of age on 1 November 2024. They must be born after 1 November 1989.
- Candidates may only apply once.
- Applications may be submitted in French or English (other languages are not accepted).
- Candidates must be registered in a French university or in a co-tutored program for the 2024-2025 academic year.
- PhD students enrolled in a 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> year of a thesis in Humanities and Social sciences may apply.
- Only PhD students in their 4<sup>th</sup> year in Matter, Natural and Life Sciences are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must not have defended their thesis by 31 December 2024.

## **HOW TO APPLY**

Candidates must complete the online form and send the application in pdf format and as a single file to <a href="mailto:prix.jeune.chercheur@fondationdestreilles.com">prix.jeune.chercheur@fondationdestreilles.com</a> before midnight on 31 October 2024, including, in the following order:

- a cover page with your first and last name, your year of registration, your discipline, the title of your project and the name of your research supervisor
- a curriculum vitae
- the list of your publications
- a summary of your research project (1500 characters)
- a detailed presentation of your current research project (3 to 5 pages), including a description
  of the issue, a justification of your research project, the methodology you are using, the
  topicality of the subject studied and any elements that will enable you to assess how far your
  research has progressed
- two letters of recommendation from leading scientists, at least one of whom must be from outside the thesis supervisor, who know you and can give an assessment of your work
- the certificate of registration of the thesis' subject delivered through the
   "application Step" via the institution where you are defending your thesis, including
   the date of your first registration, or a certificate of administrative registration in the
   thesis delivered by the research services, also including the date of this first
   registration
- a photocopy of your valid identity document

If the form or file is missing or incomplete, the application will be rejected.

Applications are examined by the scientific committee in February or March of each year. The decisions of the scientific committee are final and confidential. You will be informed of their decisions by 31 March at the latest. Application files will not be returned.

## **LAUREATES**

The prize is strictly nominative. It cannot be paid to a research laboratory or any other public or private organization. The prize may be used at the discretion of the winner who receives it in a single payment by bank transfer to a euro account by 30 April at the latest.

Laureates undertake to:

- participate to the prize-giving ceremony (date to be specified)
- inform the foundation of the results of their research (thesis defence, publications) by
   sending a message to prix.jeune.chercheur@fondationdestreilles.com
- notify in the publication of their work the support of the Fondation des Treilles and, in the case of a book, indicate the following formula:
